Network Growth (through global call 2022)

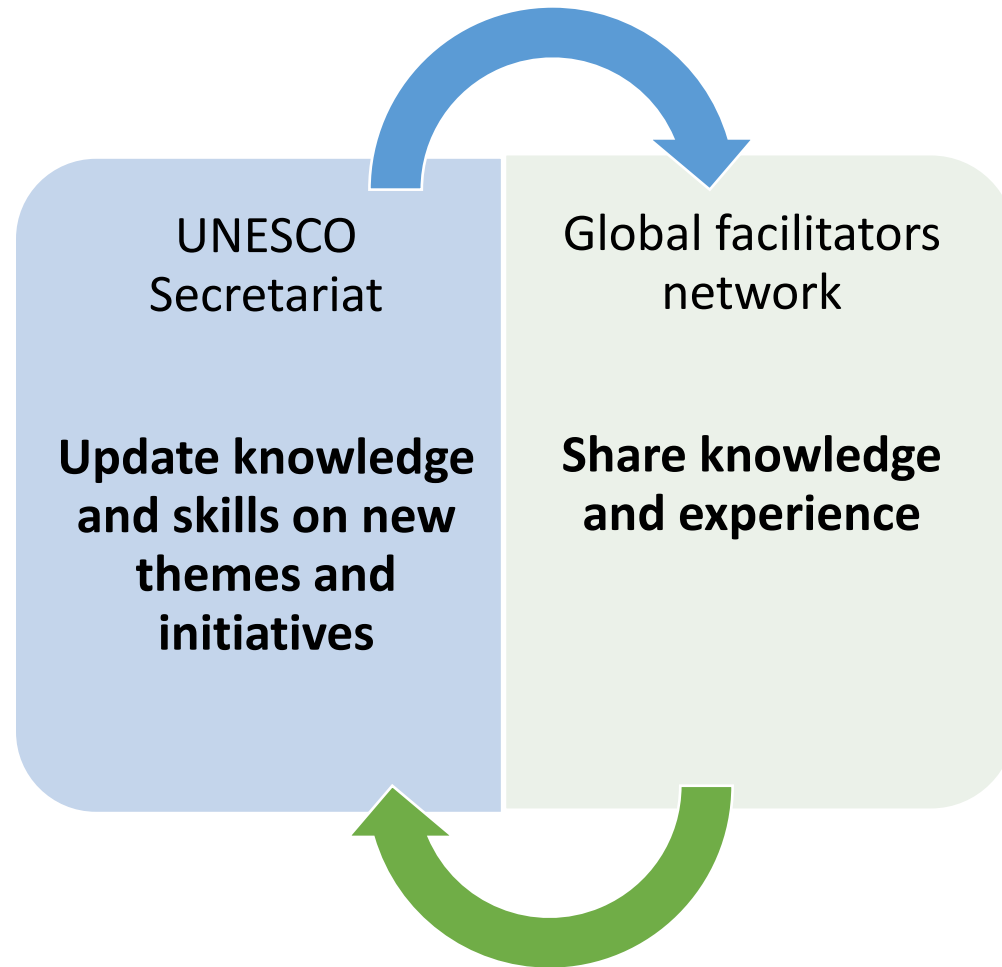
- Expanded to 247 members across all regions
